The Geetha Arulmohan Scholarship Award and Internship Program has been established to honor the memory and legacy of Geetha Arulmohan, who dedicated over fourteen years as the Executive Director of Mercer Council. Geetha's unwavering commitment to reducing the devastation caused by addiction in Mercer County left an indelible mark on our community. In her memory, this scholarship program aims to provide financial aid and an invaluable educational experience to aspiring individuals who are pursuing education, certification, and/or licensure in the fields of prevention, social work, counseling, and/or substance-related challenges. The scholarship award not only provides financial support but offers an opportunity to engage with our agency, and our community, through an internship.

#### Scholarship and Internship Details:

- Amount: The Geetha Arulmohan Scholarship Award starts at \$500. Applicants that complete an internship with our agency will be eligible to receive a total scholarship amount of \$1,000, to be used towards tuition costs and/or textbook fees only.
- Eligibility: The scholarship and internship program is open to Mercer County residents and individuals attending school in Mercer County who are pursuing education, certification, and/or licensure in fields related to prevention, public health, social work, sociology/psychology, counseling, or other substance- or behavioral health related challenges. This includes, but is not limited to, degrees or certifications such as CADC, CPS, LCADC, CPRS, CHES, or Bachelors or Masters Degrees.

#### Internship Commitment:

- To qualify for the full scholarship amount of \$1,000, recipients must commit to an internship at Mercer Council. The internship is an excellent opportunity to gain practical experience in the field and make a meaningful contribution to our mission of addressing addiction and behavioral health challenges in Mercer County.
- Internship duration and weekly hours will be determined in consultation with the recipient, ensuring a flexible and enriching experience.

#### Application Deadline: Annually on the first Friday in May.

#### **Selection Process:**

A selection committee composed of three (3) Mercer Council staff and three (3) Board members will evaluate applications based on academic qualifications and eligibility, the quality of the written essay, and the application's expressed interest in interning with our agency. The seventh, "tiebreaking" member of the selection committee will be the agency's Executive Director.

### **Our Commitment to Inclusivity:**

The Geetha Arulmohan Scholarship Award and Internship Program is open to applicants of all ages and backgrounds who are eligible based on the aforementioned criteria. Our commitment to fostering diversity and inclusivity is reflected in our scholarship program and we welcome applicants from a wide range of experiences and life stages.

We understand that the internship component may not be suitable for all applicants due to various commitments and circumstances. Therefore, please note that the internship opportunity is optional. Applicants have the choice to apply for the **scholarship only**, or to explore the **scholarship with the internship option.** This flexibility is designed to ensure that the scholarship program accommodates the diverse needs and goals of our applicants. Those interested in exploring possibilities of completing an **externship** should contact us for further discussion.

**Note:** This scholarship and internship program aim to not only provide financial support for education, but also to foster a deeper connection between scholarship recipients and Mercer Council. It represents an opportunity to make a significant impact on the community and to carry forward Geetha's legacy.
